## Using Music to Focus ... ... And Have Fun

This is what our Goofin' Around Keyboard Classes call a "Wellness Activity", something even beginner musicians can do to mindfully experience music helping us feel better. I recommend it for structuring your playing time anytime!

Start by playing one of your favorite songs -- a song you've played before that you feel confident playing. Play it as many times as you want.

Then switch to a different song that requires more concentration. Perhaps a new song you are learning. Focus carefully on the song, using the techniques you learned from your lessons. When you have played it a few times ... stop.

Finish your playing time by choosing another song that you like and are more comfortable playing. Enjoy the feelings of accomplishment and success.

This activity allows us to begin and end our playing time on a pleasant note. We can combine a challenge with pleasure.

This activity can also be used to change our focus when we are worried, sad, angry, frustrated, or overwhelmed. The song in the middle that requires focus helps break those "loops" in our minds.
